MINUTES Special Meeting Thursday, August 25, 2022

A. ROLL CALL

Mayor Nagy called the meeting to order at 6:12 p.m. Present were Council Members Collazo, Freitas, Bucci, and Vice Mayor Hannon.

B. CITY MANAGER REPORTS

1. Adopt a Resolution Finding That There is a Proclaimed State of Emergency; Finding That Meeting in Person Would Present Imminent Risks to the Health or Safety of Attendees as a Result of the State of Emergency; and Authorizing Continued Remote Teleconferenced Meetings of the Legislative Bodies of the City of Newark for the 30 Day Period Beginning August 25 Pursuant to AB 361 Resolution No. 11399

City Attorney Kokotaylo gave the staff report recommending approval.

No one from the public requested to speak.

Vice Mayor Hannon moved, Council Member Bucci seconded to adopt a resolution finding that there is a Proclaimed State of Emergency; Finding That Meeting in Person Would Present Imminent Risks to the Health or Safety of Attendees as a Result of the State of Emergency; and Authorizing Continued Remote Teleconferenced Meetings of the Legislative Bodies of the City of Newark for the 30 Day Period Beginning August 25 Pursuant to AB 361. The motion passed, 5 AYES.

2. Safety, security, and meeting disruption procedures

City Attorney Kokotaylo gave a brief overview of disruptive meeting behavior and First Amendment considerations. He stated that, the general rule was that a person could potentially be removed from a meeting if their conduct was disruptive to the meeting. A person could not be removed based on the content of their comments.

Captain Macias introduced the Police Officers Arroyo and Losier.

Police Officer Arroyo reviewed disruptive behavior situations and the City Council options to recess the meeting or exit the Council Chambers.

Police Officer Losier reviewed scenarios in which to run, hide, or fight.

No one from the public requested to speak.
